General information

The last election of Austrian Members of the European Parliament was at the 2019 European election on 26 May 2019.

Eligibility to vote

All Austrian citizens who have reached the age of 16 on and including election day and who are not barred from voting are eligible to vote in the European elections. In addition, these persons must be registered in the municipality in Austria in which their main residence is located by the deadline.

Non-Austrian citizens of the European Union who have their main residence in Austria can choose between the right to vote in Austria or in their Member State of origin. To be able to contribute to the election of Austrian Members of the European Parliament, you must submit an application for registration in the EU electoral roll to the municipality of your main residence. After registration on the electoral roll, the European Union citizens remain registered for the **duration of their residence in Austria**. This registration does not expire until and unless the citizen moves abroad.

The application for registration in the EU electoral roll for an Austrian citizen residing abroad is valid for a maximum of 10 years, after which registration in the EU electoral roll must be applied for again.
