Vorarlberg student grant

Promoting study and research stays abroad

The Province of Vorarlberg supports Vorarlberg students in their study or research stays at scientific institutions abroad. The aim is to strengthen the exchange of ideas and experiences – at scientific, economic and cultural level – beyond national borders and to promote international mobility as a key competence for scientific and professional careers.

Student grants may be awarded for short-term study and research stays abroad at universities, higher education institutions and universities of applied science, other publicly recognised research centres, libraries, archives, museums, hospitals and other scientific collections, as well as corporate research and development departments.

Target group:

- Students at a university, higher education institution or university of applied science who have completed at least the first year of their basic studies; and
 Craduate appleadamics
- Graduate academics

Conditions

- Austrian citizenship or citizenship of one of the Member States of the European Union or European Economic Area
- Main or secondary residence continuously in Vorarlberg for at least 3 consecutive years at the time of application
- Study or research stay abroad at a university, higher education institution, university of applied science or other publicly recognised research centre
- In the case of full-time studies at a foreign higher education institution/university: study or research stay in a third country

Documents required

Application form with annexes (listed in the form)

Dates and deadlines

Deadline for submission: Before the start of the stay abroad.

Settlement:

Within 8 weeks of the end of the stay abroad.

Costs and payments

One-off provincial contribution of up to EUR 350 per month for a minimum of 1 month and a maximum of 4 months
