Vorarlberg scholarship for students

Funding for students in financial need

The Province of Vorarlberg grants support to students who are in financial need and who complete their studies during the specified period of study. The purpose of the scholarship awarded by the Province of Vorarlberg is to enable as many people in Vorarlberg as possible to benefit from higher education, and to improve their academic conditions.

Target group:

• Regular students receiving initial education at higher education institutions, universities of applied science and universities in Austria and abroad

Conditions:

- Austrian citizenship or citizenship of one of the Member States of the European Union or European Economic Area
- Main or secondary residence in Vorarlberg for at least 3 consecutive years at the time of application
- Financial need
- Minimum duration of studies (+ 'grace semester')
- Start of studies before the age of 45
- It is the student's first period of studies
- No entitlement to a student grant from the federal government
- No support for school education (e.g. advanced courses), for studies or training in other (post-secondary) educational institutions, or for further training or university courses.

Documents required

Application form with annexes (listed in the form)

Dates and deadlines

Applications may be submitted during the current academic year.

Costs and payments

- Maximum EUR 2 500 per academic year (for students who need to have a second residence at the place of study and students who are self-sufficient)
- Maximum EUR 1 250 per academic year (for students who do not need to have a secondary residence at the place of study)
- These amounts apply for each academic year (and can be reapplied for each year)
